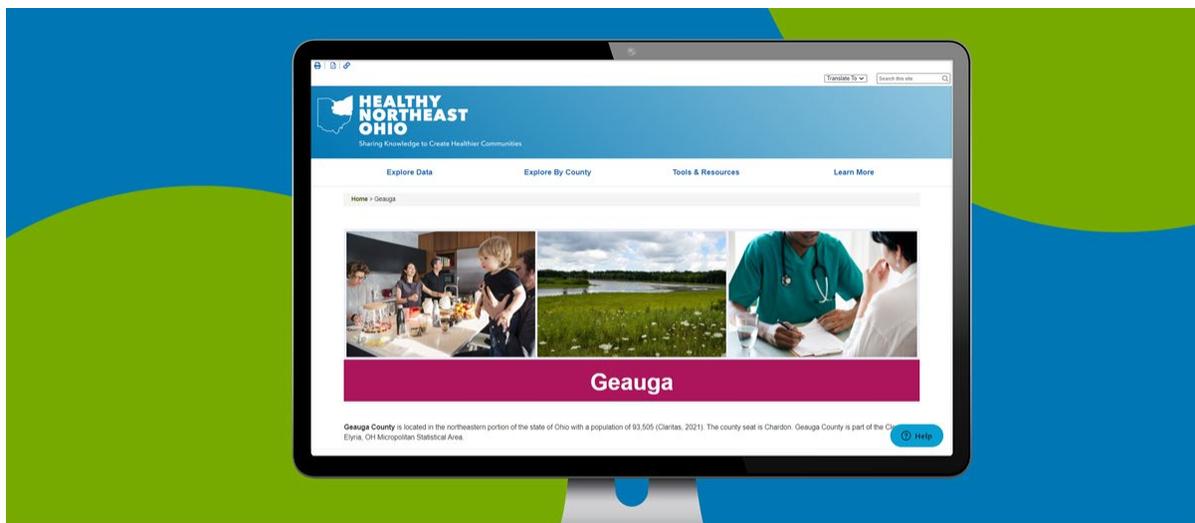
Dear Colleagues and Partners,

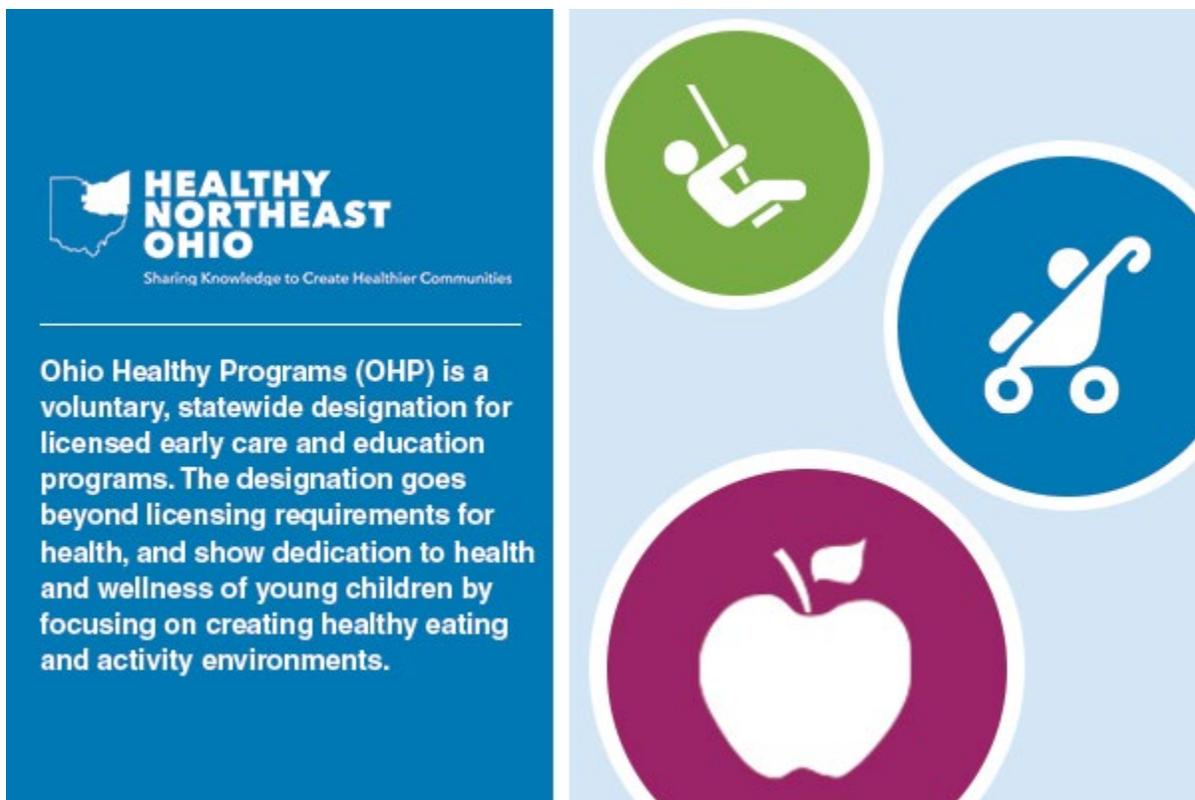
Site Updates

This dashboard includes approximately 250 demographic elements from Claritas, available at the state, region, county and zip code levels. Food Insecurity Index

The Healthy Northeast Ohio [Food Insecurity Index](#) has been updated for 2021. The index is a measure of food access that is correlated with social and economic factors. An index value is given to all zip codes, census tracts and counties in the Healthy Northeast Ohio region to help

identify areas of need. Visit the specialty dashboard today to learn more about the index and methodology.

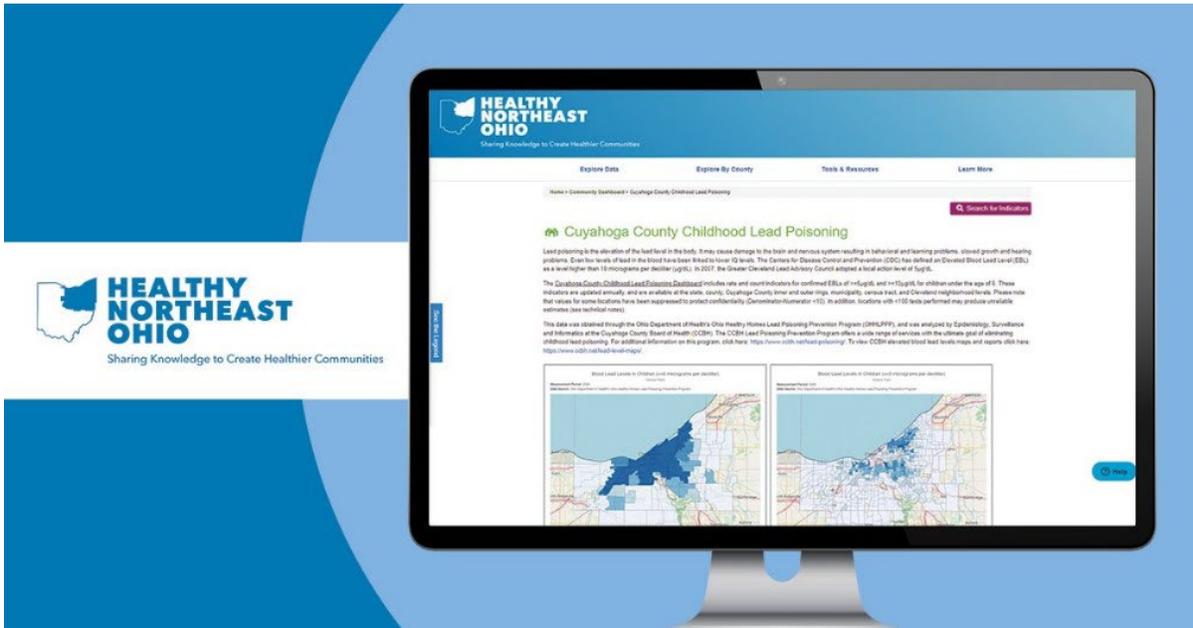


CDC PLACES and U.S. EPA Data

Several new data indicators from CDC PLACES have been updated for 2018 and 2019 on Healthy Northeast Ohio. Lead Data

2020 Cuyahoga County childhood lead poisoning data is now available. The updated dashboard includes rate and count indicators for confirmed elevated blood lead levels of $\geq 5\mu\text{g}/\text{dL}$ and $\geq 10\mu\text{g}/\text{dL}$ for children under six.
